## TOURNAMENT RULES

### Team Responsibilities.

1. Upon arriving at the gym, each team's coach is responsible for checking the team in at the check-in-table. If the schedule gets ahead we will try to start games early.
  2. A team must have a minimum of 5 players ready to play 10 minutes before the scheduled game time.
  3. Each team is responsible for its own warm up balls, as well as personal belongings.
- All players must have numbered jerseys (numbers can either be on the front or back).

### Playing Rules.( Check Rules posted at the tournament in case of changes.)

1. Length of Game. There will be two -16 minute halves with a running clock. **Coaches please note this does affect end of game strategies.** Games will have 2 minute half times. Warmups will be 5 minutes between games but we may adjust the time to stay on schedule. Please be on time for your scheduled game. With a short amount of time between games please move your belongs out of the bench area quickly. We will have the lunch room area to use for team use also.
  2. Substitutions may be made during any dead ball situation. The official will wave the player(s) onto the court.
  3. Game ball: A game ball will be provided for all games. Please bring your own warmup balls.
  4. Jump balls: Jump balls will be used to start games and each overtime period. Alternating possession arrow will be used for the remainder of the game.
  5. Time-outs. Each team will be permitted one 30 second time-out per half (clock will stop), with no carry over from halves. Time-outs will not be carried over into overtime period(s). If a team calls for time-out and does not have a time out – Possession will be awarded to the other team.
  6. Overtime: Will be sudden death – First Team to score. No Timeouts. 2 Minute Max Time. Then alternating Free throws will determine the winner.
  7. No Pressing.
  8. No Zone Defenses.
  9. No 3 Point Goals will be allowed.
  10. Free Throws: Please have your players hustle to the line. Clock is running. Refs will be instructed to keep this moving.\*Free throws will be shot on all shooting fouls throughout the game. \*Bonus (one plus one) on all non-shooting fouls beginning on the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul of half. \*Double Bonus (2 shots) on all non-shooting fouls beginning with the team's 10<sup>th</sup> foul of the half.
  11. All fouls (technical and/or personal) will count toward the total team fouls per half and toward a player's fouls for disqualification.
  12. Any player or coach who receives his or her first technical foul must leave the playing area (OUT OF THE GYM) for the rest of that game. If any player or coach receives a second technical during the tournament, he or she will be asked to leave the facility immediately for the remainder of the tournament. I don't anticipate this being a problem.
  13. Medals will be awarded to First, Second Place and Third Place.
  14. Entry fee for fans is: \$3 adults and \$1 for students -Family Pass for \$7.
  15. \$25 of the entry fee will be kept to cover gym rental costs and other costs in case of cancellation due to weather. Dropping out of the tournament will forfeit your entry fee.
